

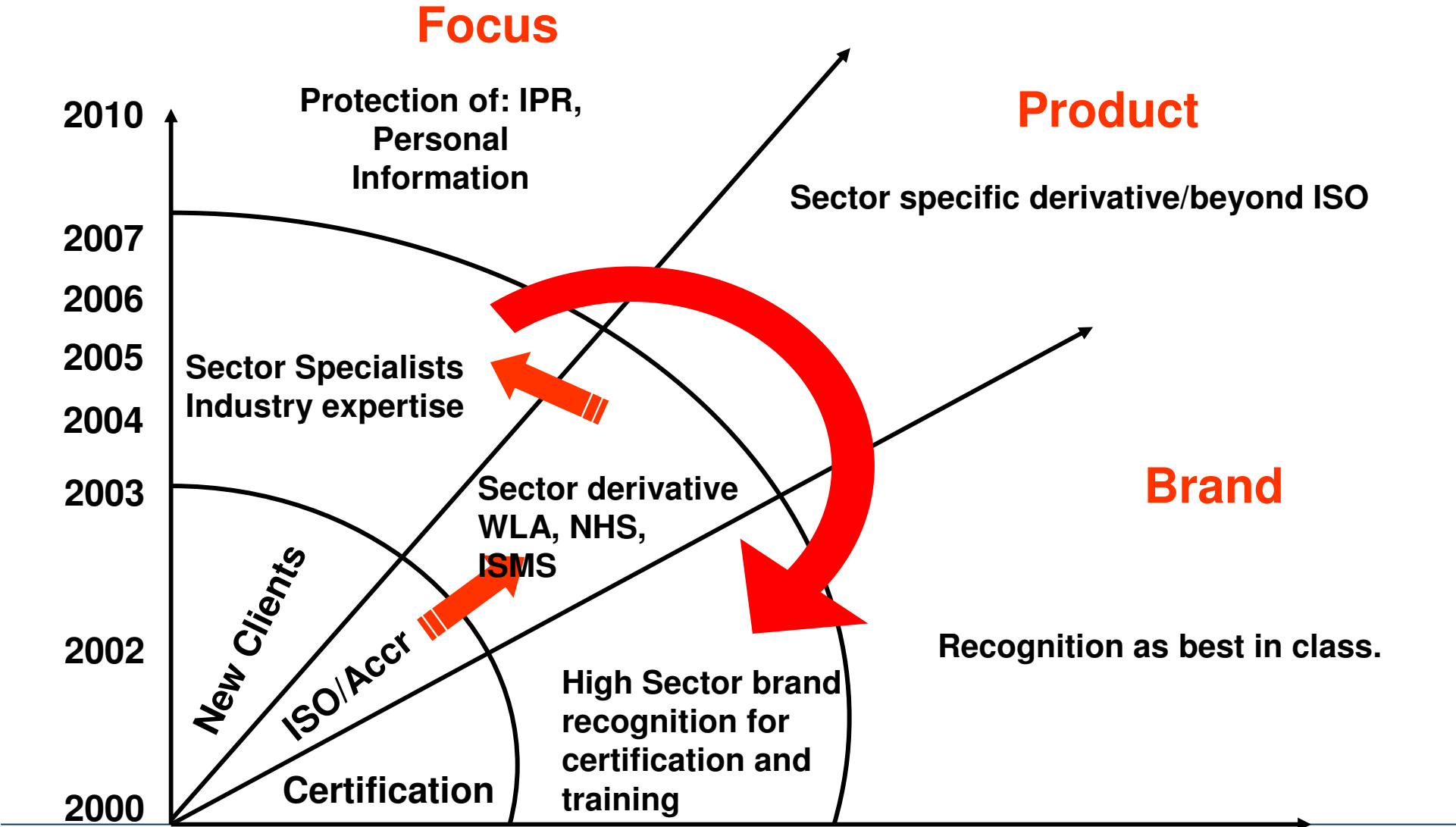

Standard	Media Disposal
<b>Purpose</b>	To ensure that all media containing sensitive information is disposed of in a manner commensurate with the sensitivity of the information contained therein.
<b>Statement</b>	<p>The relevant Data and System Owner is to develop procedures to ensure that all media is to be securely erased or rendered unreadable before disposal. Tapes and removable discs must be degaussed, where such facilities are available. Hard discs must be rendered below level formatting or securely erased.</p> <p>Where an external organisation is used for media disposal, the contract must prohibit unauthorized disclosure of Company information. A provision for regular confidentiality visits should also be included to monitor the destruction process.</p>

### Standard Media Disposal

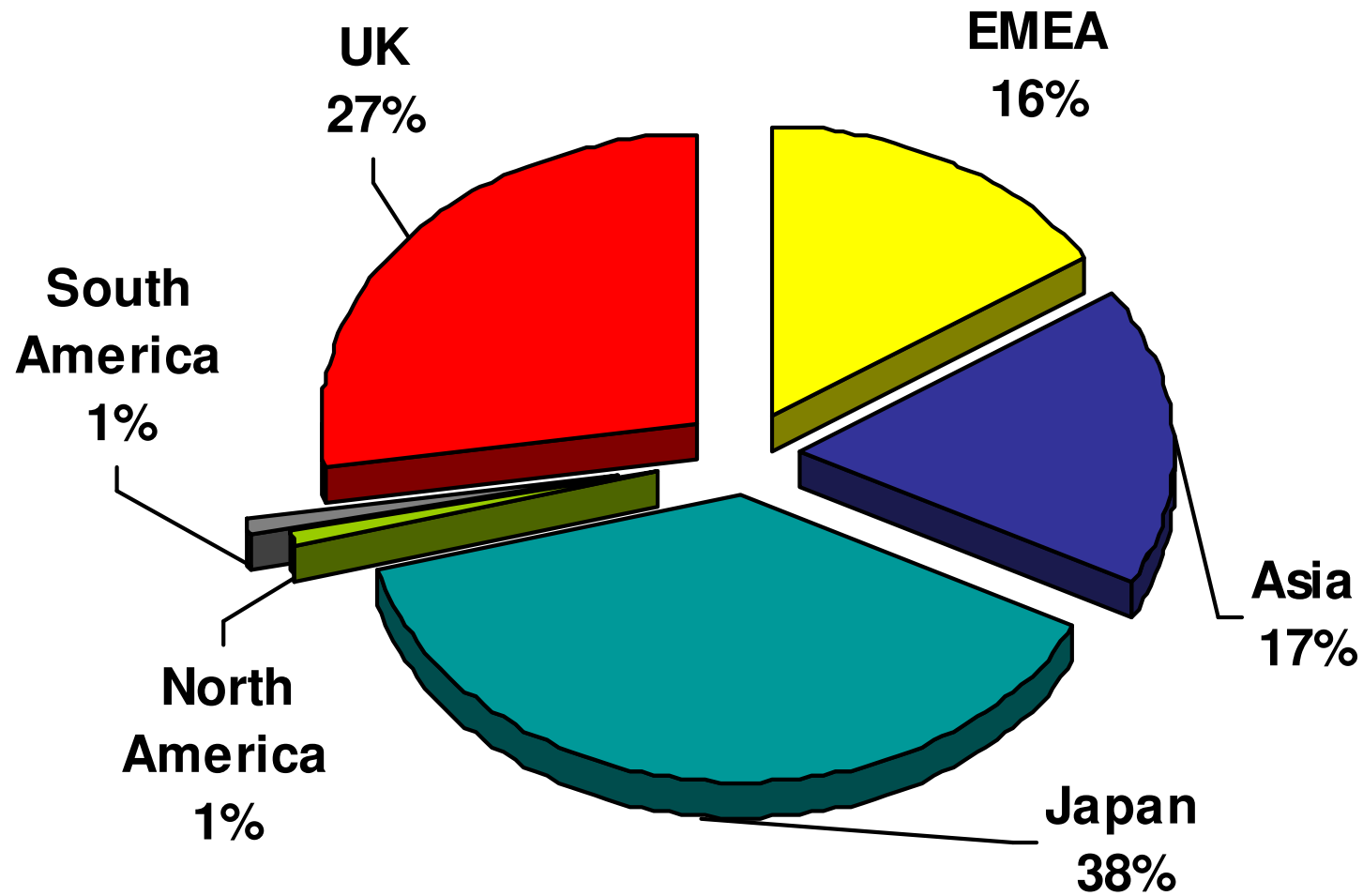
**Purpose** To ensure that all media containing sensitive information is disposed of in a manner commensurate with the sensitivity of the information contained therein.

**Statement** The relevant Data and System Owner is to develop procedures to ensure that all media is to be securely erased or rendered unreadable before disposal. Tapes and removable discs must be degaussed, where such facilities are available. Hard discs must be subjected to low level formatting or securely erased. Where an external organisation is used for media disposal, the contract must prohibit unauthorised disclosure of Company information. A provision for regular confirmatory visits should also be included to monitor the destruction process.
